Conflicts will be worked out between coaches and Pam Drummond, once the schedule is set. If you know for sure that you cannot play on a specific day, please attach a note to your roster, and we will attempt to accommodate the request in the schedule. Teams may choose to make up a game during their practice time. **BOTH** coaches must contact Pam Drummond to let her know of those arrangements. If you have 2 Pony teams, we will try to schedule those games back to back.

Each team will need to complete 2 forms. (3 IF YOU HAVE NEW PLAYERS)

1) Roster Please complete with players names, and note any updated phone or address information

Roster limit is 12. State rules require that each player play a minimum of half of the game.

We have several players looking for teams, so if you have room, please contact Pam Drummond. Ideally, we'd like to place every child who wants to play on a team.

2) Practice field request We will not receive the permits for SM School fields until mid to late February. We will not have Indian Hills for the spring, as it will be used by SM East.

Pony teams are expected to use grassy areas, with their pop up goals, leaving the soccer field for older teams.

The Shawnee Mission School District issues permits for their fields to Heartland Soccer Association, who in turn issues them to NEU and the other clubs in Heartland. The school district may issue a permit to other organizations or groups for some nights of the week.

Please complete the form, indicating your first and second preferences. NEU does not have access to enough fields for teams to have an entire field or in some locations even half a field for their entire practice. Once requests are submitted, the schedule will be completed.

Please note that U9 and older teams, U8 teams as well as Pony teams will also be completing requests. Final practice field assignments will not be done until Under 8 and Pony teams turn in their requests. U9 and older teams will begin their season practices prior to the start of U8 and Pony team practices. NEU attempts to grant a team's first request for a practice field or time, but that is not always possible. If there is more than one team using the same field, please share.

Once you have completed your request, you may NOT change the day, time or location of your practice without contacting Sean Molen, Field Coordinator (molen@kc.rr.com), to determine if the change is possible.

3) Registration form(s) for any new player to your team NEU Registration forms are available on line **All forms are available on the NEU website (www.neusoccer.org). under the Registration tab.**

Players may play on only 1 team. This rule is posted on the NEU website, under "Registration".

Recreational team fees: League fee for Pony teams is \$40

Beginning this season, Pam Drummond will be taking over registration of U8 and Pony teams teams. Please contact her if you have questions, or want to add players to your roster, once you have turned in your roster. Please make note in your message that it is in regard to a PONY team.

You may add players prior to playing your 3rd game. Information must be to Pam by 5pm on Wednesday, if you want the player to play that week. She will be placing a box on her front porch for you to put your paperwork, etc. in.
