If you need additional players, please let Pam know. We already have 3-4 players looking for a team for spring 2012, both Pony and U8.

**PLEASE CHECK WITH YOUR PLAYER'S PARENTS TO DETERMINE IF THERE ARE DAY(S) YOUR TEAM IS UNABLE TO PLAY. (First Communion, scouting activities, school activities)**

**Once the schedule is posted, if you need to reschedule a game, it MUST BE REQUESTED 10 DAYS IN ADVANCE.**

### **Spring REGISTRATION PAPERWORK:**

**Each team will need to complete 3 forms. (4 IF YOU HAVE NEW PLAYERS)**

**All forms are available to down load from the NEU website: ([www.neusoccer.org](http://www.neusoccer.org)) Forms can be found under the COACHES LINK, and then click on the REQUIRED FORMS..**

**1) Roster** Please complete with players names, address, phone number, and birth date.  
Please be sure that this information is correct.

Under 8 teams play 8 V 8 (7 field players and a goalie). **The roster limit is 16.**

Pony teams play 6 V 6 (5 field players and a goalie). **The roster limit is 12**

**2) Conflict form** Each team may request **NO MORE** than 2 days (or a part of a day) when their team

is unable to play. Once the schedule is posted, **reschedules MUST be requested 10 days in advance. Check with parents for dates for school/scouting/church or other conflicts. Remember that each request impacts every team.**

BOTH teams must contact the coordinator and agree to the change BEFORE the game will be rescheduled.

**3) Practice field request** We will not receive the permits for SM School fields until late February, early March, and we will not know until we receive the permits, if the SM School District will make all fields listed as possibilities on the request form will be available.

The Shawnee Mission School District issues permits for their fields to Heartland Soccer Association, who in turn issues them to NEU and the other clubs in Heartland. The school district may issue a permit to other organizations or groups for some nights of the week.

Please complete the form, indicating your first and second preferences. NEU does not have access to enough fields for teams to have an entire field or in some locations even half a field for their entire practice. Once requests are submitted, the schedule will be completed as quickly as possible.

**Confirmation of practice day/time/location will be e-mailed to you.**

Please note that U9 and older teams as well as the U8 and Pony teams will also be completing requests. Final practice field assignments will be completed as soon as possible. U9 and older teams will begin their season practices prior to the start of U8 and Pony team practices.

NEU attempts to grant a team's first request for a practice field or time, but that is not always possible. If there is more than one team using the same field, please share, and use grassy areas for drills, etc. Pony teams are expected to use grassy areas with their pop-up goals for practices.

Once you have completed your request, you may NOT change the day, time or location of your practice without contacting **NEU ([info@neusoccer.org](mailto:info@neusoccer.org))** to determine if the change is possible. If you are unsure of the locations of possible practice fields, check the NEU website ([www.neusoccer.org](http://www.neusoccer.org))

We have practice field space available at the site of the former Roeland Park School.

**4) Membership form(s)** for any new player to your team

NEU membership forms are available on the website—under “registration”...and then registration forms. The form does not need to be notarized.

**Players may play on only 1 team. This rule is posted on the NEU website, under “Registration”. If you have questions, contact Pat Monaghan or Pam Drummond.**

**Recreational team fees:**

**League fee for Under 8 teams (first and second grade) is \$55**

**Pony fee: \$40**

**Check should be made out to “NEU”**

Pam Drummond is responsible for registration of Pony and U8 teams. Please contact her if you have questions, or want to add players to your roster, once you have turned in your roster. You may add players prior to playing your 3rd game. Information must be to Pam by 5pm on Wednesday, if you want the player to play that week. She will be placing a box on her front porch for you to put your paperwork, etc. in.
